Beginning February 1, 2006, Quad County Corn Processors will offer free price later for corn delivered to QCCP. The term of this price later contract will be December 15, 2006.

All free price later contracts must be priced by December 15, 2006. Contracts will not be extended beyond this date. Bear in mind that all price later corn must be priced against

the near-by (spot) market. In other words, price later can not be used in conjunction with a forward contract.
